Lessons Learned

The following is what I have learned so far. The first and foremost part is to be obedient to God's Word and the Holy Spirit. In being a Christian does not mean there are no consequences to our actions (good or bad). Being led by the Holy Spirit and by reading and doing the actions in the Holy Bible will prevent problems in our life.

Prayer is more important than you think. He (God) makes the *best* out of our *mess*.
